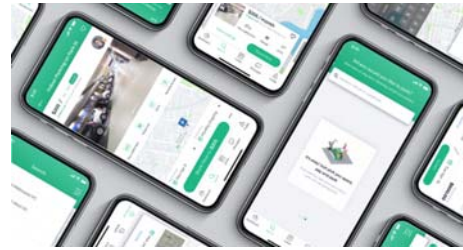

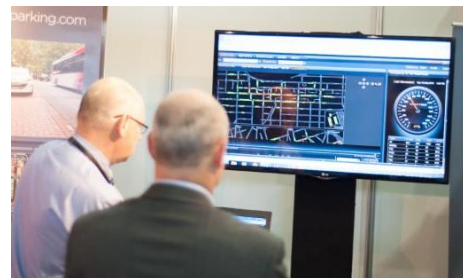


Finalists Announced in 2019 National Parking Awards
