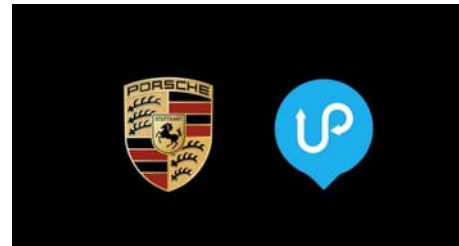


Call for nominations - Board of Directors
