## Secure Parking ensures safer car parks in the event of sudden cardiac arrest

In Australia, around 30,000 people suffer a sudden cardiac arrest each year and on average only 10% of these people survive. In most cases, these people survived because there was some-one nearby who knew how to help in these situations.
